Dear Parents/Carers

As I am sure you are aware, from  $12^{th} - 15^{th}$  May in school the year six children will be sitting their End of Key Stage 2 SATs tests. They will take place as follows:

Monday 12<sup>th</sup> May – Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: Paper 1 (Punctuation and Grammar) and Paper 2 (Spelling)

Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> May – Reading Test

Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> May – Maths: Paper 1 (Arithmetic) and Paper 2 (Reasoning)

Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> May – Maths: Paper 3 (Reasoning)

The End of Key Stage 2 tests draw from the curriculum taught during years three, four and five, as well as their learning in year six. We have been revising prior learning in class and through optional homework set on the Atom Learning platform.

## **Year Six Revision Packs**

We have put together a revision pack which year six pupils can work on during the Easter break should they wish to. The intention is to help pupils revise aspects that they would like to look at a little more in order to boost understanding and confidence.

The revision pack contains five reading comprehension tasks, five SPaG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) booklets, and five maths packs. The tasks are not intended to be completed under test conditions and are not timed pieces.

Answers for each of the revision tasks will be available on the class page of the school website should you wish to go over any work completed. There will also be opportunities during the school week for pupils to go through their completed work with Miss Davey.

Raffle tickets will be given for completed tasks from the Easter revision pack and will add to the raffle tickets earned for completion of Atom Learning homework.

Each completed comprehension task is worth one raffle ticket (5 tickets available in total).

Each completed maths booklet is worth two raffle tickets (10 tickets available in total).

Each completed SPaG booklet is worth two raffle tickets (10 tickets available in total).

Any pupils who complete 10 tasks/booklets will be awarded a merit. Any pupils who complete all 15 tasks/booklets will be awarded two merits.

Raffle tickets will be given on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> April. All completed, named tasks should be returned to Miss Davey by Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> April.
