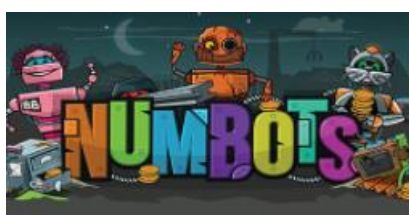
Design and Technology
