



## Welcome to Robins Class Newsletter Term 6 – June 2025

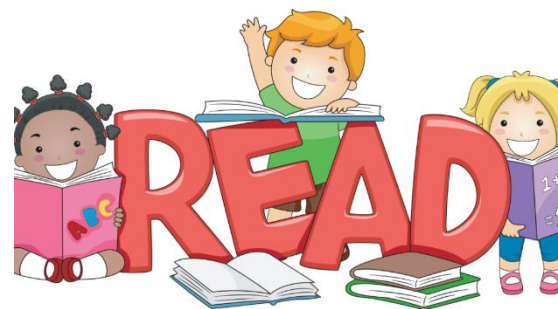
Dear Parents,
