



Rabbits Spellings Term 1

New spellings will be sent home **each Tuesday** to be practised during the week at home and tested the following Monday – See dates below.

Pupils also have a Spelling Shed account (login details are in their Reading Record Book), that gives them access to the online games which will support them in learning the weekly spellings. We would like children to spend **at least 10 minutes per week** playing these games as it will really help strengthen their recall.

In the spelling test we **may** also include other words with the same spelling pattern to see if they can apply the rule, spellings from previous weeks as well as the Year 2 Common Exception words that we will also have been practising in school. (See next page)

Monday 6 th October	Step 4: Words where 'c' makes a /s/ sound before 'e', 'i' and 'y'	race, ice, cell, city, fancy, lace, space, circle, circus, rice
Monday 13 th October	Step 5: Words where 'kn' and 'gn' make a /n/ sound at the beginning of words	knock, know, knee, knew, kneel, knit, knight, gnome, gnat, gnaw
Monday 27 th October	Step 6: Challenge Words	door, floor, poor, find, kind, mind, behind, child, children, because
