If you have any questions, I will be available after school (apart from Wednesdays) or please feel free to email the school office and they will forward the message on.

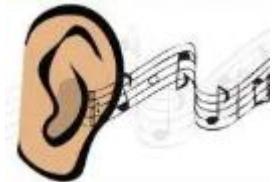
Our Curriculum

Our theme for Humanities is 'Tomb Raiders'. Children will journey back to the land of the Pharaohs and discover the fascinating world of Ancient Egyptian history. They will learn about Ancient Egyptian civilisation including the importance of the River Nile, everyday life, beliefs and rituals and gods and pharaohs. Children will learn how historians have found out about Egyptians, including interpreting hieroglyphics and discovering treasures inside the pyramids.



The children will explore the country of Egypt, locating it on a world map. They will learn about the key geographical features of the country including, rivers, land use, climate and the ancient monuments. They will investigate the many uses of the River Nile and compare the land close to the Nile (fertile land) and the desert land.

In Science, our theme is Sound. Through lots of practical activities, we will explore and identify how sound is made through vibrations in a range of instruments and look at how pitch and volume can be changed.



Long term homework is not set formally but if your child is interested in researching something related to our humanities or science topics, they are more than welcome to do so and share their findings with the class. This could be a PowerPoint, poster, pictures and facts or model, for example.

Mathematics

For Maths, we use the White Rose scheme of learning. This term we will be learning about place value followed by addition and subtraction. We will be revising what the children have learnt previously and building upon this to work with numbers up to one thousand.



Year 4 will have their National Multiplication Check towards the end of the year. Before the check, we will hold a parent meeting to give you all the relevant information. All children also need to be practising their timetables (using TT Rockstars). Login details can be found in the front of their reading record books. The children will complete a minimum of one soundcheck, 5 Studio games and 5 Garage games each week. This should take around 11 minutes and can be completed at home or at school. The children will receive 5 house points for completing them all and the whole class will receive 5 class points if they all complete their allotted sessions.



Weekly Spellings

We are now using Spelling Shed to teach and practice spellings. They will have a 30 minute lesson every Tuesday which will focus on a spelling rule or pattern, followed by spelling activities throughout the week linked to the spelling rule or pattern being studied.

A list of the spelling rules/patterns will be sent home weekly with the children, sometimes along with optional activities for them to complete. The terms spellings will also be made available on the class page of the school website.

Each Monday your child will have a spelling test based on the spelling patterns from the week before. We may also include spellings from previous weeks as well as the Year 5 common exception words that we will also be practising in school. They will complete their test in spelling books which will be marked and then sent home for you to share. New spellings will be sent home each Tuesday to be practised during the week at home and tested the following week in school.

Pupils will also have a Spelling Shed account, that gives them access to the online games which will support them in learning the weekly spellings. We would like children to spend at least 10 minutes per week playing these games as it will really help strengthen their recall.

PE- Year 4 PE day is Friday

Our PE topic this term will be basketball. We will be learning basic techniques such as passing, dribbling, catching and shooting. We will put all of our learning into practice with mini games where the children learn the rules of basketball as well as good sportsmanship. Please can you make sure your child has the right PE kit. No earrings are to be worn on PE days unless your child can take them out themselves, they will need a small pot to keep them safe. Our PE lessons will be outside this term- if it not raining- so please ensure your child has tracksuit bottoms for the colder weather, even if they keep them in their locker just in case.

Reading

In Year 4, the children continue to use the Accelerated Reading programme, where children have been assessed at the beginning of term, in order to identify a level in which they need to read at. They need to read within this range – they do a quiz on the book once they've read it and this gives us an indication of the comprehension. Quizzes can only be done in school. The aim is to get 100% in a quiz and so sometimes a child might be asked to choose a lower level based on their level of comprehension, rather than fluency alone.



We have noticed that a lot of the children are not reading at home, please could you try to encourage them as much as possible. Reading really does have a big impact on all their learning.
