



Badgers Spellings Term 1

New spellings will be sent home **each Tuesday** to be practised during the week at home and tested the following Monday – See dates below.

Pupils also have a Spelling Shed account (login details are in their Reading Record Book), that gives them access to the online games which will support them in learning the weekly spellings. We would like children to spend **at least 15 minutes per week** playing these games as it will really help strengthen their recall.

In the spelling test we **may** also include other words with the same spelling pattern to see if they can apply the rule, spellings from previous weeks as well as the Year 5 Common Exception words that we will also have been practising in school. (See next page)

The spelling test at the start of term 2 will be a selection of the words learnt from term 1.

To be tested on	Objective	Words
Monday 22 nd September	Step 1: Words that are homophones or near homophones	not, knot, weather, whether, accept, except, peace, piece, plain, plane
Monday 29 th September	Step 2: Words with the prefix 'in-' meaning 'not'	inability, inactive, inadequate, incorrect, incurable, indefinite, inelegant, inflexible, insecure, invisible
Monday 6 th October	Step 3: Words with the prefixes 'il-', 'im-' and 'ir-'	illegal, illegible, immature, immortal, impossible, impatient, imperfect, irregular, irrelevant, irresponsible
Monday 13 th October	Step 4: Words with the prefix 'sub-' meaning 'below' or 'further divided'	submarine, subject, subway, submerge, subtropical, subdivide, subheading, substandard, subtitle, submit
Monday 27 th October	Step 5: Words with the prefix 'inter-' meaning 'between' or 'among'	interact, intercity, international, interfere, interview, intercept, intercom, internet, interchange, interface
