New spellings will be sent home **each Tuesday** to be practised during the week at home and tested the following Monday – See dates below.

Pupils also have a Spelling Shed account (login details are in their Reading Record Book), that gives them access to the online games which will support them in learning the weekly spellings. We would like children to spend **at least 10 minutes per week** playing these games as it will really help strengthen their recall.

In the spelling test we **may** also include other words with the same spelling pattern to see if they can apply the rule, spellings from previous weeks and two dictation sentences.

To be tested on	Objective	Words
Monday 3 rd November	Step 7: Words ending in '-ation'	information, sensation, preparation, vibration, decoration, donation, duration, registration, population, determination
Monday 10 th November	Step 8: Words ending in '-ation'	adoration, admiration, coronation, detonation, observation, location, generation, exploration, combination, illustration
Monday 17 th November	Step 9: Words ending '-ly'	sadly, completely, wildly, bravely, gently, foolishly, proudly, horribly, nervously, happily
Monday 24 th November	Step 10: Words ending '-lly'	usually, finally, beautifully, thoughtfully, wonderfully, carefully, faithfully, peacefully, cruelly, generally
Monday 1 st December	Step 11: Words where 'ch' makes a /sh/ sound	chef, chalet, machine, brochure, parachute, chute, chaperone, chandelier, crochet, quiche
Monday 8 th December	Step 12: Challenge Words	favourite, complete, continue, experiment, February, naughty, material, knowledge, remember, famous
