New spellings will be sent home **each Tuesday** to be practised during the week at home and tested the following Monday – See dates below.

Pupils also have a Spelling Shed account (login details are in their Reading Record Book), that gives them access to the online games which will support them in learning the weekly spellings. We would like children to spend **at least 10 minutes per week** playing these games as it will really help strengthen their recall.

In the spelling test we **may** also include other words with the same spelling pattern to see if they can apply the rule, spellings from previous weeks and two dictation sentences.

To be tested on	Objective	Words
Monday 12 th January	Step 13: Words ending in '-sion'	expansion, extension, comprehension, tension, suspension, exclusion, provision explosion, erosion, invasion
Monday 19 th January	Step 14: Words ending in '-ous'	poisonous, dangerous, mountainous, marvellous, perilous, tremendous, enormous, jealous, precious, disastrous
Monday 26 th January	Step 15: Words ending in '-ous' incl. those where 'ge' from the base word remains	courageous, outrageous, nervous, famous, adventurous, disadvantageous, ridiculous, carnivorous, rapturous, torturous
Monday 2 nd February	Step 16: Words where a suffix is added to words ending in 'y'	merriment, happiness, plentiful, penniless, happily, prettiest, nastiness, beautiful, pitiful, silliness
Monday 9 th February	Step 17: Words ending in '-ious' and 'eous	serious, obvious, curious, hideous, spontaneous, courteous, furious, various, victorious, gaseous
Monday 23 rd February	Step 18: Challenge Words	extreme, although, breath, caught, different, exercise, medicine, thought, business, possession
