

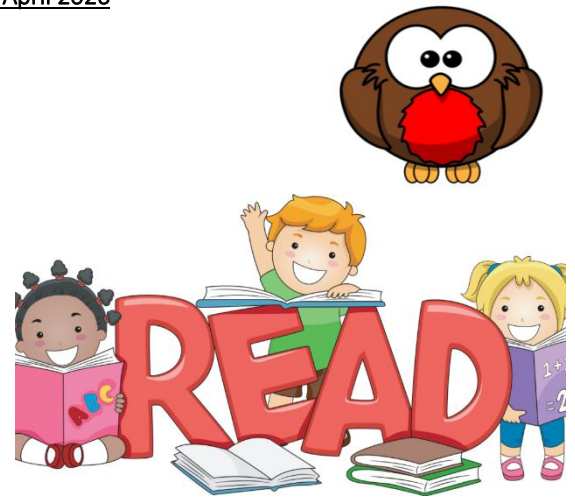
Welcome to Robins Class Newsletter Term 5 April 2026

Reading
